Sir,

On the careful consideration of the inspection report submitted by the Inspection Committee vide letter No. Shiksha-SML (5-2)Inspection 300/2 dated 27.08.2011 constituted for the purpose of inspection of Private Educational Institutions of the School level for grant of permission to run/establish a private educational institution by the Govt. of H.P. Shimla vide Notification No.Shiksha-II-Chha (11)-2/2005-L dated 03-05-2006, and in exercise of the powers vested in me vide Govt. Notification No. Shiksha-II-Chha (5)-3/97 dated 16-01-2007, the approval of competent anthority with regard to issue of Permission for establishment/running/up gradation of private Educational Institution in respect of "Dayanand Anglo Vedic College Trust and Management Society" for the establishment of "D.A.V. Centenary Public School Kotkhai" for 10+1,10+2 (Arts, Commerce and Science) Classes from the academic session 2011-12 is conveyed, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- that the school concerned shall be attiliated to Central Board of School Education, New Delhi-92 for 10+1 to 10+2(Science, Arts & commerce) classes.
- 2 that the State Govt. will not provide any type of financial assistance/Grant-in-aid etc. in respect of the said institution.
- 3. that the admission in the institution shall be made strictly in accordance with the norms as lay down by the Board of School Education to which the school is affiliated and no discrimination on the basis of caste, colour, creed and sex shall be made. No pupil shall be refused admission on account of his caste creed or religion.
- that the private institution shall employ only the trained/eligible staff as per the norms fixed by the Govt.
- that no particular religious education shall be imparted by the institution to maintain secular character of the institution.
- that the fees and funds shall be such that they are not of exploiting nature but contribute to the spread of education. They should be commensurate to the salary of the staff being paid, development of infrastructure and facilities and activities being provided to the students.
- that the permission to run or establish a private educational institution shall be granted only on individual basis and the institution shall not be entitled to open its branches elsewhere.
